

FiRM's Shredded paper finds a new home!

The Division's standard procedure is to shred any waste paper which may contain confidential or sensitive budget and finance related information. The shredded paper is then placed into the recycling bin for a weekly collection.

During September 2005 the Division responded to a request from Monash Animal Services to supply shredded paper for use in animal containers and habitats, thereby reducing the need for Animal Services to purchase a similar paper product.

FiRM now routinely puts aside its shredded paper into large plastic bags and every few weeks it is collected by a staff member from Animal Services.

By diverting the majority of its waste paper to this initiative, FiRM has reduced its need for a recycle paper collection to once every three weeks and has helped Animal Services to reduce their costs.
